An outline was given by C.E.Z.R. Free. Comments from both Councils were put forward.

Members of Hanjaffur with their Chairman Mr Keith Williams presiding were given another room for their discussion afterwards re-joined Hanworth with their objections and also some positive actions.

This concluded the joint discussion and Mr Keith Williams thanked Hanworth Community Council for their invitation.

SUMMARY OF OBJECTIONS

- The area marked is practically all controlled by the National Trust.
- Have they been contacted and if so what is their response?
- Access to rights impractical.
- Existing roads are of a low classification number.
- Large vehicles would cause potential blocking of the 17470 while entering onto the bridge
- Village avoidance would be imperative.
- Disturbance to land and wild life should new access (s) be required.
- Cause a blot on the landscape and effect tourism in the area.
- Designated SSSI land.
- This is an area of extremely low flying by the R.F.F.

Appears to be marked facing west, work sufficiently when facing south.

SUPPORT

- NOT against renewable energy and believes less intrusive
- Renewables should be installed.
- Also supports small renewable generation that supply individual and local needs. e.g. Hydro.
