a) HIGHWAYS ISSUES.

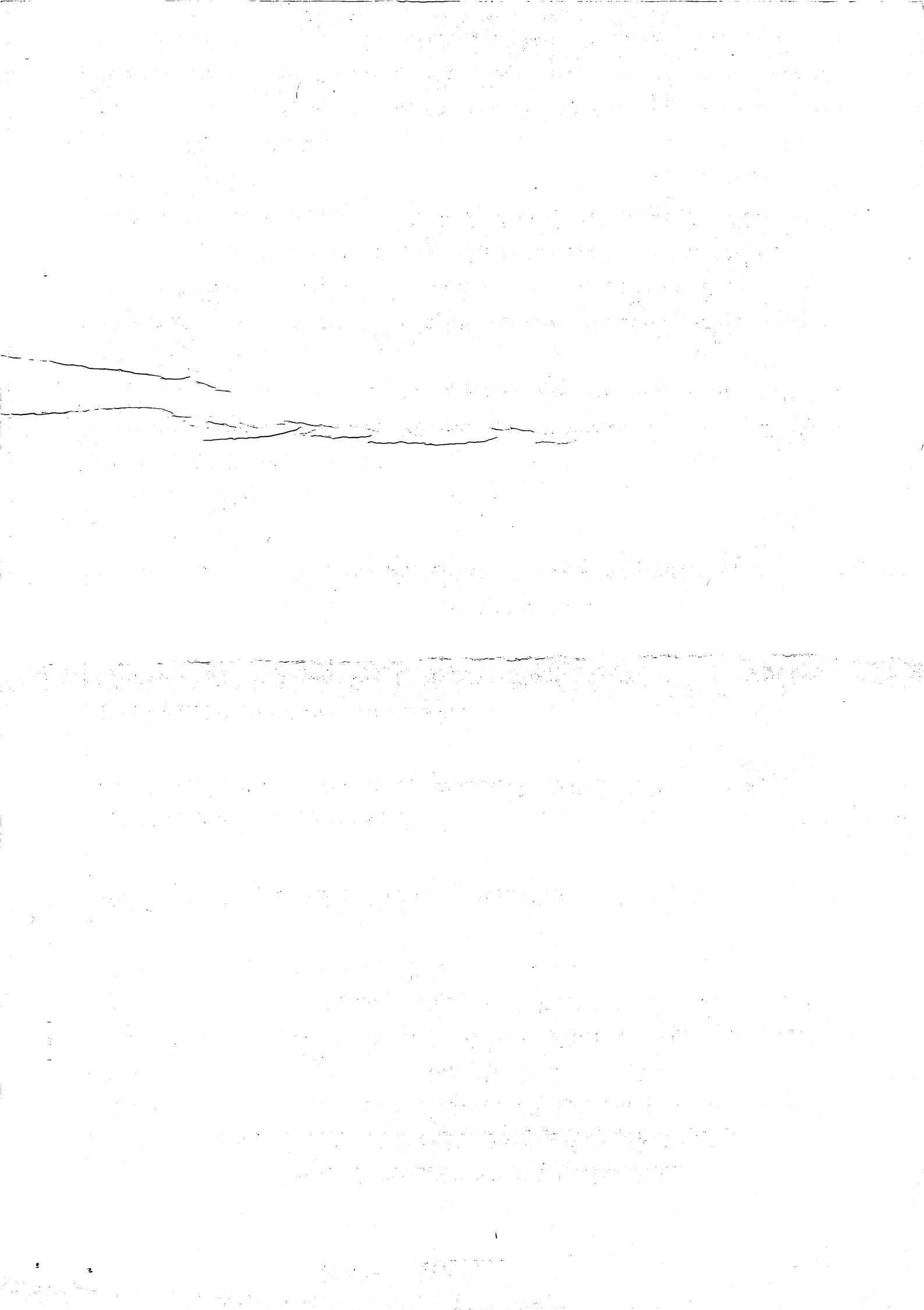
Work as requested has been carried out on the potholes. Reference was made to spraying carried out in the village.

Auditing now request sufficient financial reserves in place to function for at least a six month period in advance. Agreed reserves adequate.

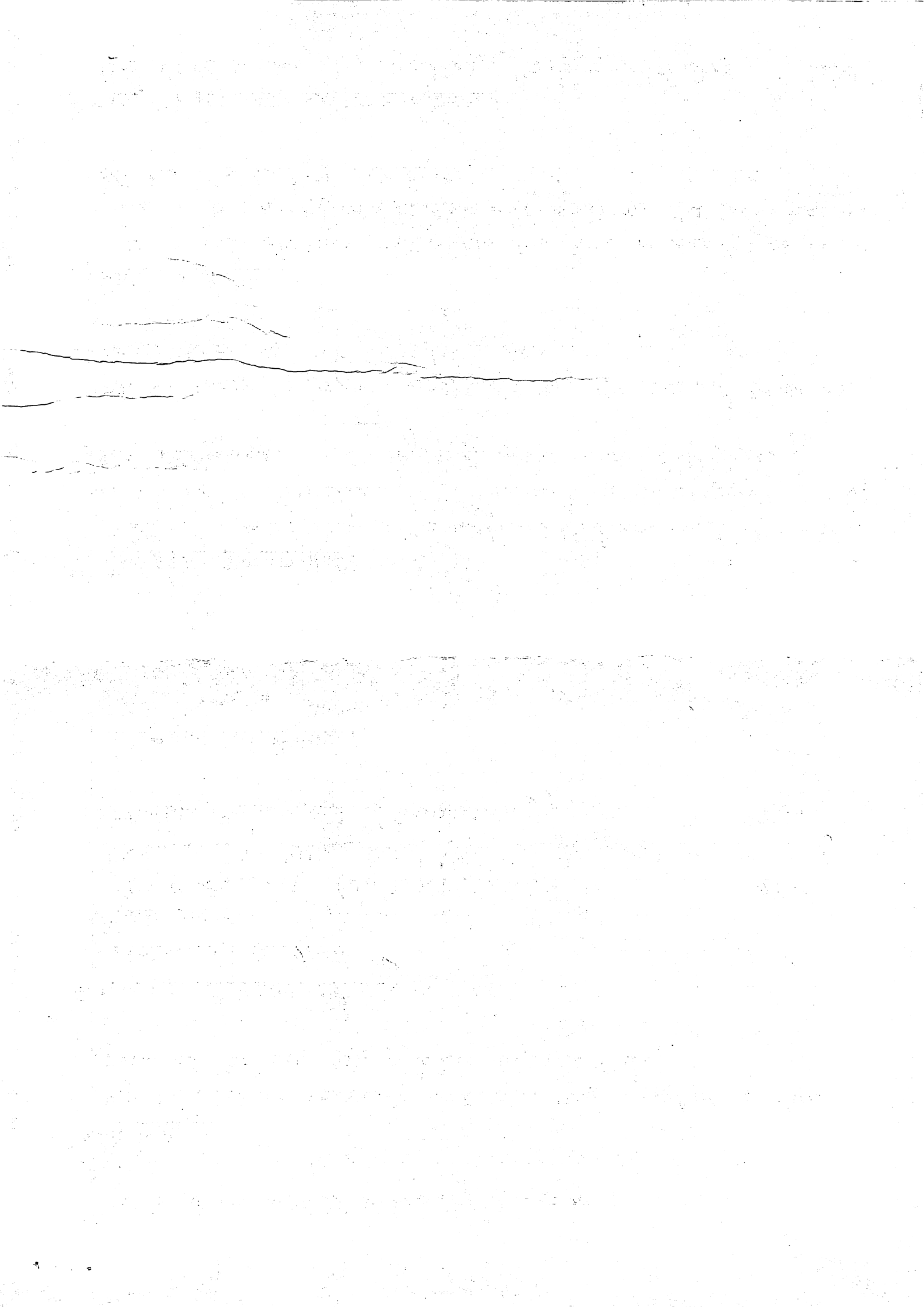
